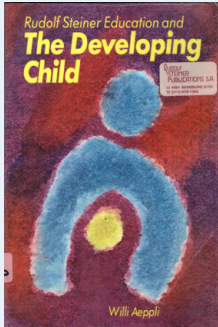

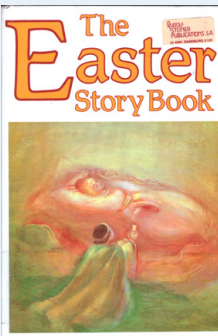

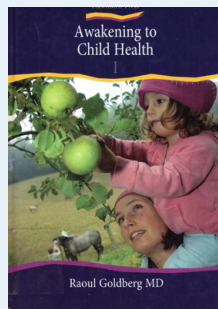

This collection of over 30 stories, legends and folk tales. Some of the stories, like “St Veronica” are placed in the context of the great Easter and Whitsun events.

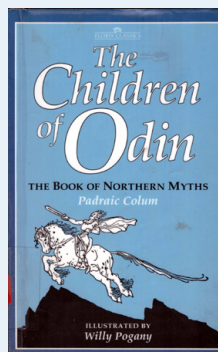

Dr Raoul Goldberg draws on his research, medical work and Rudolf Steiner’s insights.

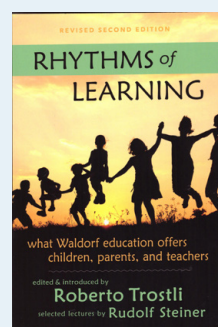
